

NOTICE OF BOND RESOLUTION

TOWN OF GRAND ISLAND

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a bond resolution, a summary of which is published herewith, has been adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Grand Island, County of Erie, on October 3, 2011 and the validity of the obligations authorized by such resolution may be hereafter contested only if:

(1) (a) such obligations were authorized for an object or purpose for which the Town of Grand Island is not authorized to expend money or

(b) if the provisions of law which should have been complied with as of the date of publication of this notice were not substantially complied with

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of publication of this notice; or

(2) such obligations were authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution of New York.

SUMMARY OF RESOLUTION

The following is a summary of a bond resolution adopted by the Town Board of the Town of Grand Island on October 3, 2011. The proceeds from the sale of the obligations authorized in said resolution shall be used to finance a portion (\$100,484) of a certain capital improvements project within the Town that consists of the installation of approximately 1,235 lineal feet of 18-inch gravity sanitary sewer along Whitehaven Road, the replacement of the existing manhole at the intersection of Whitehaven Road and Harvey Road, the routing of the existing 12-inch force main into the first manhole at Bonnywoods Crossing, and the abandonment of the existing force main, all of the forgoing to include all necessary site work, equipment, apparatus and other improvements and costs incidental thereto, at an estimated maximum aggregate amount of \$181,129. Said bond resolution authorizes the issuance and sale of a serial bond or bonds and a bond anticipation note or notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of said serial bonds for the portion of the costs of such Project attributable to the residents of the Consolidated Sewer District, in an amount not to exceed \$100,484, said amount to be offset by any federal, state, county and/or local funds received. The period of probable usefulness for said purpose is 40 years.
