A LOCAL LAW ADOPTING THE TOWN OF GRAND ISLAND RIGHT TO FARM LAW

Notice is hereby given that the Town Board of the Town of Grand Island shall hold a public hearing at 8:00 PM on November 7, 2011 at Town Hall, 2255 Baseline Road, Grand Island, New York, 14072, for the purposes of considering and possibly adopting a local law adopting the Grand Island Right-to Farm Law. The general purpose and intent of this law to maintain and preserve the rural traditions and character of the town, to permit the continuation of agricultural practices, to protect the existence and operation of farms, define agricultural practices that shall not be found to be a public or private nuisance, provide notice of farm activities, and to promote new ways to resolve disputes concerning agricultural practices and farm operations. Copies of the proposed local law are available at the Office of the Town Clerk at the above address. At the time and place above, all members of the public shall be heard.
