The Town of Grand Island is seeking a Full Time Conditional Permanent Junior Sanitary Chemist. The work involves performing chemical and biological analysis of water and sewage in a Wastewater Treatment Plant Laboratory. This is technical work involving responsibility for the accurate performance of chemical analysis. This position is subject to the requirements of Erie County Civil Service.

Typical Work Activities

Prepares and checks standard solutions and reagents; sets up laboratory equipment and performs various physical and chemical analyses;
Collects and examines samples of water and sewage for the purpose of controlling the operation of the sewage treatment process;
Prepares and maintains files of chemical reports; keeps records of supplies and equipment; maintains housekeeping of the laboratory;
Supervise the work of plant operators in specific chemical procedures and tests

Minimum Qualifications:

- A. Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university with a Bachelors degree with a specialization in chemistry or biological sciences; or
- B. Graduation from a two year technical college with an Associates degree with a specialization in chemistry or biological sciences and two years of satisfactory experience in a Public Health or Industrial Laboratory; or
- C. An equivalent combination of training and experience as defined by the limits of (A) and (B).
