

Parks and Recreation Seasonal Maintenance Worker

Distinguishing Features of the Class:

5 month seasonal position with potential additional time status, working knowledge of buildings and grounds maintenance procedures and equipment as related to a park needs, ability to perform a variety of skilled maintenance and repair tasks to buildings, park facilities & equipment, repairs and maintenance to motorized equipment ranging from small hand equipment to larger mowing and grounds machinery. Also, certification in pesticide application and/ or play equipment inspection is a plus qualification.

Typical Work Activity:

Responsible for efficient and safe operations for routine servicing and maintenance of equipment and motor equipment. Maintaining maintenance reports and records under supervision of full time staff, cleans, paints structures, machinery and equipment. Assists in limited amount of outside grounds maintenance, inspection of equipment and structures. Unloads and distributes supply deliveries to various park locations.

Minimum Qualifications:

High School diploma, preferably 1 - 3 yrs experience in motor equipment and vehicle repairs. The ability to work well with others, ability to follow detailed oral and written instructions, dependable and good physical condition.

Essential Knowledge, Skills and Ability:

Mechanical aptitude with pesticide license, and or play equipment inspection certification.
