2. (15 min.) Stacey Roeder (Face to Face): Stacey reported that unless a meeting is "mandatory" parents don't usually show up because no parent believes that their child will be involved with drugs. The major drug problem communities are facing is prescription pills and heroin. Stacey feels that Grand Island needs an early intervention program which would be triggered through punishment phase, perhaps a referral as part of an ACD. She said that kids don't believe that there is uniform enforcement if caught with pills, and that if they develop a using problem, and are asked how this could have been prevented, they overwhelmingly say that they shouldn't have been allowed to get away with it the very first time. Kids face no consequences. Mandatory parent meetings need to come from community demand and not the school administrators. Fact to Face is in 27 school districts. One out of every 5 kids is abusing prescription drugs. Average age of experimentation is 12.3 years old. Programs such as the Character Council run by Jerri Parisi in the High School are a great way for children who do not use drugs to feel secure with their decision and feel that they are not alone.
